"Son, we're going to Hell."

The navigator of the USS *Houston* confided these prophetic words to a young officer as he and his captain charted a course into U.S. naval legend. Renowned as FDR's favorite warship, the cruiser USS *Houston* was a prize target trapped in the far Pacific after Pearl Harbor.
